Clarity of presentation	Presentation is incomprehensible or does not present information to peers in a useful manner. Group fails to emphasize virtually any important ideas.	Presentation is mostly clear and understandable, though it could have been organized more carefully. Group fails to emphasize one or more important ideas.	Presentation is clear and understandable. Information is presented in a logical format. Appropriate factors/information is emphasized in presentation/lesson.
Engagement	The group does not provide classmates with an opportunity to actively engage the material.	The group provides at least one opportunity for classmates to engage the material.	The group provides several opportunities for classmates to engage with the material through a variety of handouts, activities, visuals, etc.
Visual aid	There is no visual aid or visual aid is disorganized or uninteresting.	Visual aid is attractive and well-organized, but does not convey information in an interesting way.	Visual aid is attractive, well-organized, and conveys information in an interesting and engaging way.
Creativity	Group plans are not appropriate to the content and do not demonstrate creativity.	Group plans are appropriate to the content but are not particularly creative or engaging.	Group plans show evidence of consideration regarding the presentation of ideas in a thoughtful, colorful, or otherwise engaging manner.
Accuracy of information	Group fails to accurately grasp the fundamental ideas underlying the movement or there are many errors that impede understanding.	Group demonstrates knowledge of most of the fundamental ideas/beliefs underlying the movement, but there are one or two errors that don't impede understanding.	Group demonstrates knowledge of the fundamental ideas/beliefs underlying movement and presents these accurately to the group.
